Some attempts have already been made to repeal minor consent laws that have been on the books for 30 years 39 and to require parental notification for adolescents receiving STD care, 40 which has long been considered a confidential service for minors in every state. So far, most such efforts have not succeeded, but it is not yet clear how state and federal laws and policies will evolve as implementation of the HIPAA privacy rule proceeds.

A: In many states adolescents have the right to independently consent to outpatient mental health or substance abuse treatment. A minor's right to consent to treatment often, but not always, corresponds with the right to protect the privacy of treatment records.

Mandatory parental consent or notification laws do not promote family communication, do not protect the physical or emotional health of young women, and may, in fact, do harm. Judicial bypass procedures also risk causing medical and psychological harm to the pregnant adolescent. Adverse Impact on Family Communication

Most physicians prefer to have adolescents communicate with parents and involve them in important health care decisions, but they recognize that within some relationships, parents' knowledge of substance use or sexual activity can hinder the minor's treatment and might lead to punishment or abuse. Sixty-eight percent of participants informed a parent of their PID diagnosis and of that group, 49% reported receiving supportive care in the form of medication reminders, advice or comfort. Neither age (adolescent vs. young adult,  $p=.701$ ) nor group assignment (CHN intervention vs. control,  $p=.499$ ) was associated with parental notification.
