Basic Concepts. Teaching EFL reading is a bit different than the way native speakers are taught to read. While vocabulary is an important part of reading, teaching the reading skills of surveying, skimming, scanning, inference, predicting and guessing are just as important. Research tends to indicate that a student's reading comprehension can be improved by focusing on teaching students skills in the following areas:

Step 1: Engage the student. The first step in teaching reading to ESL students is to get the students "warmed-up" by engaging them in the topic of the reading passage. The purpose of engaging the student is to introduce the theme or topic of the reading. The student can be engaged, for example, by using visuals or a "warm-up" conversation.

Teaching Reading to ESL Students

1. Scanning. This is a great follow-up activity after skimming, enhancing your students ' comprehension of the reading even further. Scanning is much like skimming, allowing your students more time to review the reading material, but without letting them stew or converse over every word.

A good strategy to teach all readers is that instead of just rushing through a passage or chapter, is to pause and generate questions. These can either be questions about what has just happened or what they think might happen in the future. Doing this can help them focus on the main ideas and increase the student's engagement with the material.
